How my child will be learning

The EYFS Framework explains how and what your child will be learning to support their healthy development.

Your child will be learning skills, acquiring new knowledge and demonstrating their understanding through **7 areas of learning and development**. Children should mostly develop the **3 prime areas** first. These are:

- Communication and language;
- Physical development; and
- Personal, social and emotional development.

These prime areas are those most essential for your child’s healthy development and future learning.

As children grow, the prime areas will help them to develop skills in **4 specific areas**. These are:

- Literacy;
- Mathematics;
- Understanding the world; and
- Expressive arts and design.

We use these 7 areas to plan your child’s learning and activities. We make sure that the activities are suited to your child’s unique needs. This is a little bit like a curriculum in primary and secondary schools, but it’s suitable for very young children, and it’s designed to be really flexible so that staff can follow your child’s unique needs and interests.

Children in the EYFS learn by playing and exploring, being active, and through creative and critical thinking which takes place both indoors and outside.



Active learning through play

Each day in class 1 is exciting! Activities are planned and purposeful, but always have the children and their interests at the heart of them. Children are encouraged to raise questions, explore and investigate. Learning takes place everywhere. Our classroom offers a bright, stimulating learning environment. Children and adults alike love it. We have a large outdoor classroom, nature area and garden. Learning also takes place in the local community. Visits are made around the village and visitors are invited in. Once a week the children don their wellies and go to the local woods where everything from maths to music is taught.
