Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to tell you about some of the key information you and your child will need to know for the year ahead.

Class 5 privileges:

As the oldest in the school, Class 5 children are expected to act as role-models to the other pupils. They take on many responsibilities and, in return, have many privileges.

Children should bring in their own pencil cases; children may wish to bring some of the following items: pens, pencils, coloured pencils, gel/felt pens, highlighters, sharpeners, rubbers, whiteboard pens and rulers.

Homework:

Each week, your child will receive spelling homework and a piece of English and Maths.

Children are also encouraged to read regularly. Each child has been given a reading record which they must have in school every day. In Class 5, children are allowed to write their own comments, but parents can also write comments about their child's reading. Children are allowed to bring in books from home to read during registration time, however, these must be suitable for school and must challenge/help to improve your child's reading ability. The school library is also available for children to use and has a wide range of books to choose from.

PE/Sports kits:

Class 5 will have PE every Tuesday and it is important that they have a suitable PE kit (white t-shirt, blue or black shorts and trainers/daps). Children are encouraged to leave their PE kits at school; they can be left on their pegs or in their lockers. Please remember to label all items of clothing as it is difficult to return lost items to their owners when they are unnamed! Class 5 children will also need to bring in their swimming kits every Thursday in the Autumn term.
