

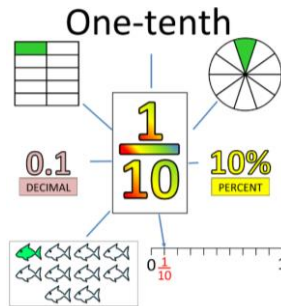

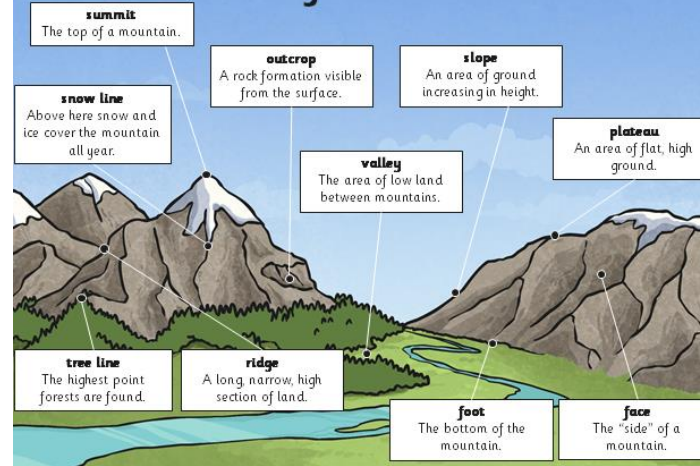

Location of the K2 Mountain.

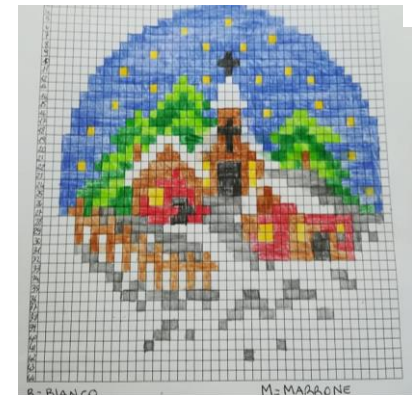
