

A single graduated pathway of Early Help and Support for children, young people and families

As a Gloucestershire school, Yorkley is committed to working in partnership with all agencies providing services to children, young people and their families. Since 2014, we have had the Graduated Pathway of support for children and young people with SEND. This development was in response to the SEND reforms resulting from the Children and Families Act (2014) and the SEND Code of Practice (2015) and provides graduated responses to support children with SEND from the moment needs are identified.

What this means for you...

As a child or young person, this means that the people working with you will help you when you need it and will not just look at one area of your life but consider everything which could be causing you difficulty.

As a parent, this means that agencies will work together with you and your child to consider all aspects of your child or young person's life that may be having an impact on their progress, development and wellbeing.
