The role of the SENCo is:

- To support the teachers in planning and supporting children with SEND.
- To refer children with specific needs to the agencies best suited to give additional assistance.
- To liaise between these agencies, the pupils, parents and teachers.
- To follow the graduated pathway.
- To offer support to SEND teaching assistants and teaching staff where required.
- To facilitate training for individuals, groups or the whole school staff as needed to improve the teaching, learning and welfare of all children.
- To liaise with the SEND Governor.
